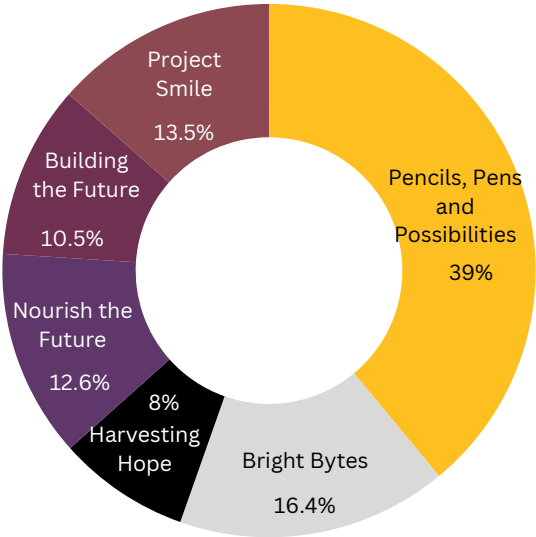

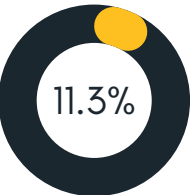

Country Fund Allocation



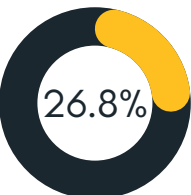

Percentage of funds allocated to Sierra Leone in 2023



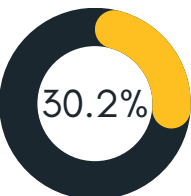
Ghana

Percentage of funds allocated to Kenya in 2023



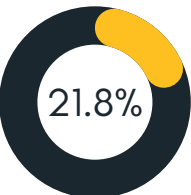
Nigeria
